To our Valued Clients,

March 20, 2020 – Regarding the COVID-19 Pandemic, Amptec have closed our office to the public and limited our office access to authorized personnel only.

March 18, 2020 – As we are monitoring the COVID-19 global crisis situation, in slowing the spread of the virus, we would like to remind everyone to keep up to date on the latest NEWS reports from the Health Authority Agencies. Governmental Authorities, Private & Public Companies and other Organizations are working 24/7 on Contingency Plans. Amptec wants to remind everyone regarding personal hygiene responsibility & social distancing.

March 16, 2020 – Due to the recent COVID-19 Coronavirus Outbreak, as part of Amptec's Contingency Plan, we have decided to postpone performing work in private suites or homes and only perform work in Common Areas until further notice. Of course, we will be in communication with the property owners and managers to evaluate the situation on a case by case basis. We will attend to only essential or emergency situations as our mandate is to ensure the safety and the health of all parties involved. As public concern regarding the COVID-19 virus continues to increase, Amptec is committed to open and transparent communication with Our Team & Our Clients regarding the virus' potential impact on our business.

Given ongoing developments of the COVID-19 virus, we would like to assure you that Amptec will continue to monitor the situation. We would like to put the following precautions in place to ensure the safety and well-being of our people:

- Availability of hand sanitizing stations throughout the office & all service vehicles
- Availability of disinfection and cleaning materials for all employees
- Increased facility wide cleaning & disinfecting adhering to Alberta Health standards
- On-site signage & reminders encouraging healthy personal hygiene

As an valued Team Member, you can help create a healthy and productive environment by following the guidelines provided by the World Health Organization on basic protective practice and good personal hygiene:

1. Wash your hands frequently with soap and hot water for 20 seconds, several times a day to prevent the spread of germs
2. Avoid touching your face, eyes, nose and mouth
3. Maintain social distancing (recommended 6 feet) from anyone coughing, sneezing or has a fever
4. Limit human and skin contact, avoid handshake or hug
5. Practice respiratory hygiene by covering your mouth and nose with your elbow or a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue away immediately and wash your hands.
6. If you have any flu-like symptoms, please stay home.
7. If you or other members are sick, please follow the guidelines outlined by the health authorities for self-isolation & self-quarantine.
8. If you feel unwell, have a fever, cough or experience difficulty breathing, please seek medical care immediately at your health center or hospital.
9. If you have traveled to an area where COVID-19 is spreading in the last 14 days and don't feel well, please notify your supervisor, contact your health center or hospital.

10. If you have returned or have family or friends living in the same dwelling that have returned from countries that are at risk, please self-quarantine for 14 days.

As the situation continues to develop, we will take direction from provincial and federal authorities, as required. For the most up-to-date and reliable information, please refer to official organizations, such as Alberta Health Services, the World Health Organization(WHO)), and the Public Health Agency of Canada.
